We will provide coordination with local builders, electricians, plumbers, architects., etc., to ensure the best possible outcome and bring more revenue into the small towns and rural areas we bring our aid to.

MISSION:

Along with a specially selected team of experts chosen for all fields necessary to accomplish set goals, we will establish a Humanitarian Aid Plan to bring new life to small town communities and rural areas that will help them thrive once again. With the unlocking of unprecedented capital through G.E.S.A.R.A., N.E.S.A.R.A, and the Global Currency Reset, along with the introduction of new technologies, we now have the opportunity and obligation to help the people in our communities within of the United States of America, thru Trumps America First Initiative.

With funding it is my intention to create a Foundation to manage multiple humanitarian projects within my county, then state, and eventually spread out to other states and communities.

This Foundation's first 1 goals will include:

- Revitalizing towns and cities including:

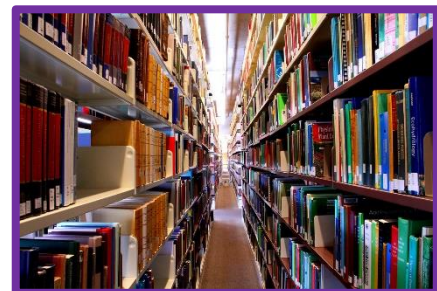
- Infrastructure/Roads/Pipelines

Our team will blanket survey these communities and hold Town Meetings to discover what is important for the local citizens of these towns to see improved in their communities and neighborhoods. We are envisioning:

- Healthy water and delivery systems
- New sewer lines and water dispersal systems
- Repaving neglected streets and parking lots
- Installing sidewalks
- Updating or new installation of streetlights
- Possible dismantling and construction of buildings
- Replacing unsafe areas and outdated schools
- Building:

 - Hotels
 - Community Centers
 - Alternative Healing Centers
 - Veterinary & Equine Health Centers
 - Entertainment Centers:

 - Movie Theatres

- Basketball Courts, Baseball/Softball Fields
- Swimming Pools
- Parks & Nature Preserve Areas
- Outdoor Skate Parks, Others as community requested
- Residential Homes
- Apartment Buildings & Duplexes, Office Space as needed
- Grocery Stores & Farmer's Market Areas
- Schools – Colleges – Universities
- Restaurants
- Planting Trees – Flowers – Landscaping, Community Gardens, Community Greenhouses
- Job Training Centers, Adult Education Centers
- Childcare Centers, Elderly Care Centers

These communities may wish to have other buildings/areas built and provided for them as we survey and quickly research their needs. There may also be funds needed for home or business repairs, or financial help for local grocers and restaurants; we would also anticipate helping in these areas as well. Updating or completely rebuilding parks with safe playground equipment, new landscaping, or general seating and enclosures to enjoy a day at the park, even building swimming pools and relaxation areas for children and adults are among the many visions we see to revitalize these areas that have needed funding for an incredibly long time. Many of these areas have sadly been forgotten in favor of larger metropolitan areas.

Emergency services, law enforcement, fire departments, search and rescue services can be supplied with new facilities, equipment, additional training, and supplies. These small communities depend heavily on these mostly volunteer departments. It would be outstanding to provide them with increased resources so they can continue to provide these necessary services to their communities.

Lack of housing is often an issue in small communities. Potential incoming residents to these newly developed and renovated areas will require adequate housing and when they cannot find that housing, they often must decline employment opportunities. The goal is to make this something that never happens again to these rural and small areas. Our organization is willing and excited to restore existing structures or build new homes and apartment buildings to help with issues such as these. Of course, land and lots of land will be purchased to provide for various needs such as this.



As agriculture is a vital part of most of these rural communities; farmers and ranchers will absolutely be included in our revitalization plan. We can help with solar water wells, water lines for irrigation of livestock, crops, and homesteads. Our organization also looks to provide safe and healthy farming education and implementation, optimal animal health education, and assistance.



Making space for Community Gardens and Greenhouses can help people learn about the importance of local food provisions and create ways for residents in these communities to volunteer their time to help each other and the town. There are many people who may love to take up gardening but may not know how. They may not know when the best time is to plant certain vegetables, herbs, flowers, and trees and we would seek to make sure people learned these important lessons so they might become more self-sufficient and see an end to hunger and malnourishment. These are just some of the ideas our Foundation has for combating these issues.

To manage the projects, we will buy or build a project office in each community we are working in to work closely with the residents of each town. There will be many temporary and permanent employment opportunities with the implementation of this humanitarian plan. After we have finished adding services to each town, we will leave them with an investment fund (paying xx amount per year) to pay for the on-going costs of the services we install.



We will set this up as a community trust fund to be managed by our Foundation, the local town council, and a professional trustee. Our Foundation's Board and Wealth Managers will also oversee these towns trusts at an executive level. Interest from the community trust fund will be set aside in another account that will allow the community to come up with their own humanitarian projects in the future, as well as provide financial help to members of the community as needed.



Once we are done working with smaller rural areas, we will shift our Foundation's focus to providing this same sort of support to the larger cities in Kentucky. Projects in these larger cities will take more resources and time and we will spend more time in each larger city out of sheer necessity. Our vision is that eventually all towns, cities, and rural areas in Kentucky are completely revitalized and upgraded to enrich the lives of the people that live in these communities.

As we finish with the revitalization of Kentucky; we look to expand outwardly to surrounding border States and work with their local organizations or institute our Foundation in helping the communities there in the same way we have done for Kentucky. In each area there may be local governments or other foundations that are helping with specific needs in these communities; we look forward to working with them in collaboration to bring prosperity, health, and safety to these areas.

The funding for these small-town projects (and eventually larger cities) is contingent with the redemption of my purchased Zimbabwe Bonds. I humbly ask for the highest rate possible to make incredibly positive changes and improvements to several small communities and cities statewide, nationwide, and perhaps worldwide. I thank you very much in advance for your utmost consideration for my humanitarian project. This really will be a labor of love and something I am very much looking forward to.

FINANCIAL NOTES:

I will aim to assist 2-5 small towns per year and eventually 1-2 large cities per year after the rural revitalization is complete. Accurate cost projections are not possible currently due to the large number of unknowns (effects of GESARA, NESARA, the GCR etc.,). A generous amount necessary to complete and keep these projects going in perpetuity is something that I will have to discuss with my wealth management team.



There are so many variables to this humanitarian project at this time that I could not possibly begin to guess what each town/rural area will need, how much it will cost, how much I will need to pay employees a generous wage to help me, or how much I will need for the costs of running my own Foundation in conjunction with each project.

Any unused capital or revenue will be used to expand my humanitarian goals, or to further support this project's work. In addition to the above project funding, I would like to humbly request a suitable percentage for "personal use" so that I can supplement personal income, help my family, friends in need, personal community projects that I may want to implement, and any other projects that I see or feel need funding in the future.

As a side note, it's always been a personal dream of mine to be able to play "Secret Santa" with people and randomly give them sizeable amounts of cash, pay off lay-a-ways in a department

store, and randomly gift people fund to help them with necessities or just help them have a better day.

I understand what an incredible responsibility this will be, and I aim to find the best teams available to help me manage the funds, help report progress of each project, and assist in any other areas as I need to make sure this humanitarian project is something that lasts for many lifetimes to come.
